OCTOBER 10, 2011, NBAA CONVENTION, LAS VEGAS, NV.....Trey Bryson, President of Jet Works Air Center announced at the NBAA Convention here in Las Vegas that Jeff Bosque, former Associated Air Center President, has agreed to assist JWAC and help them establish a small, elite 'Large Cabin Advisory Board.'

For the past several years, Jet Works has been aggressively expanding its capabilities regarding doing interior completion, refurbish and maintenance work on airline-sized aircraft which have been outfitted to operate as private jets.

Mr. Bryson stated that: "large cabin completions and interiors are one of the more challenging branches of the business aircraft industry and we are thrilled to have Jeff join us and help establish our Large Cabin Advisory Board. Jeff's experience at Associated should aid us tremendously in achieving our strategic goal of becoming more successful in the large cabin market segment In a nutshell, Jeff's been where we want to go and I really look forward to having his advice and counsel."

Mr. Bosque stated that 'I still enjoy the sights, sounds, smells and excitement of creating a new airliner business jet interior. It will be fun being able to work with Jet Works a few hours each week and to help mentor them in their expansion plans. I checked them out pretty thoroughly before saying yes and became convinced they've got the skills, talent and dedication to do outstanding work on both Boeings and Airbus aircraft.'

The Large Cabin Advisory Board to be chaired by Mr. Bosque will consist of himself and perhaps four to six large cabin aircraft operators. Their goal will be to advise JWAC on new and improved techniques and procedures they might investigate and employ that would improve and enhance the owners and operators maintainability of the aircraft, yielding reduced down time for servicing.

While Jet Works Air Center as a brand has only been in existence since 2004, the various components merged to create Jet Works Air Center have 15 years of interior, paint and maintenance and avionics services. The company currently operates out of 100,000+ square feet of hangar and office space at the Denton Municipal Airport and employs approximately 175 personnel, including over 130 technicians who are experts in the disciplines mentioned above.

During 2010 Jet Works delivered, after completing extensive interior refurbish work, five Boeing airliner business jets (one Boeing 737, one 727, three BBJs) to owners headquartered throughout the Middle East. Then in December of last year they announced they had been awarded a contract by a Saudi customer to convert an MD-87 airliner into a private jet that will accommodate 24 passengers.

The MD-87 will deliver at year's end and will feature a luxurious and contemporary cabin with a leading edge cabin entertainment system.

In additions to the MD-87 Jet Works has accomplish three major Boeing inspections along with interior refurbish work this year.
