Jet Works Air Center Applies For EASA Certification

October 10, 2011, Denton, TX....Chris Hoskins, VP Technical Service of Jet Works Air Center, announced at the NBAA Convention in Las Vegas that Jet Works had submitted application to EASA for MRO certification and authorization to perform maintenance inspection, refurbish, completion and avionics installations on EASA certificated aircraft. Hoskins said full authority was anticipated by the end of the first quarter of 2012.

Hoskins also announced that Jet Works would be undergoing the same processing in the coming month to secure Saudi GACA and UAE certifications.

Jet Works is a large MRO company based 35 road miles northwest of the DFW Airport. The company does maintenance, interior refurbishes, VIP completions, avionics and paint on Boeings, Gulfstreams, Globals, Challengers, Lears, Citations, Piaggio, and Pilatus business aircraft. All work is currently done under FAA certificate CRS: JW0R647N.

While Jet Works Air Center as a brand has only been in existence since 1996, the various components merged to create Jet Works Air Center have 30+ years of interior, paint and maintenance and avionics services. The company currently operates out of 100,000+ square feet of hangar and office space at the Denton Municipal Airport and employs approximately 175 personnel, including over 130 technicians who are experts in the disciplines mentioned above.

During 2010 Jet Works delivered, after completing extensive interior refurbish work, four Boeing airliner business jets (one Boeing 737, three BBJs) to owners headquartered throughout the Middle East. Then in December of last year they announced they had been awarded a contract by a Saudi businessman to convert an MD-87 airliner into a private jet that will accommodate 24 passengers.

The MD-87 interior will feature a luxurious and contemporary cabin with a leading edge cabin entertainment system. Trey Bryson, JWAC President & CEO, added that one of the major features of the interior will be the capabilities in terms of Wi-Fi, Internet access and communications, with virtually all contemporary formats included.
