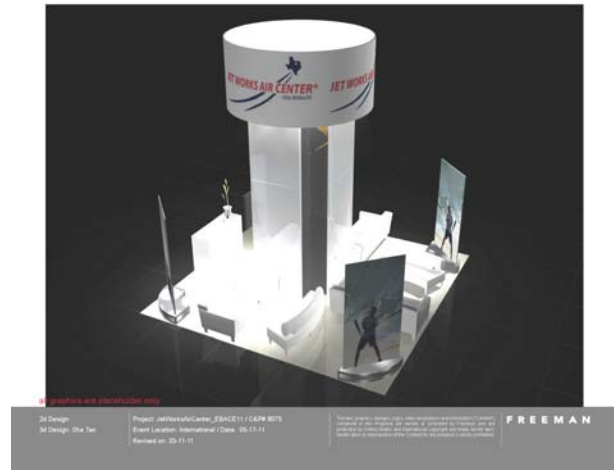

JET WORKS AIR CENTER TO

EXHIBIT AT EBACE 2011

COMPANY'S FIRST EBACE EXHIBITION

MARKS STRONG INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITY



MAY 12, 2011 DENTON, TX....Jet Works Air Center (JWAC), the aircraft completion and interior refurbish company headquartered in Denton, TX, just northwest of DFW Airport, is exhibiting its extensive large cabin business jet interior and maintenance capabilities for the first time at during EBACE 2011. This is fresh after their participation in the SIBAS aerospace exhibition a few weeks ago in Shanghai. The company also exhibited at the MEBA exhibition last December in Dubai.

Trey Bryson, president of Jet Works said their participation in EBACE, SIBAS and MEBA marks their recognition that owners and operators of large cabin private jets have limited options of getting service locally and were accustomed to having to fly long distance to have desired or mandatory service accomplished. “At SIBAS and MEBA, and hopefully here during EBACE, we have been warmly received by these operators as an option they were not familiar with. In fact, we have already signed a contract for extensive refurbish work for a BBJ from the MEBA show and we also have booked two Boeings into our schedule to come to Denton to have large maintenance scheduled service work performed.”

Bryson noted that during 2010 Jet Works delivered a Boeing 737-300 and three Boeing BBJs to owners from markets in the Middle East and Indonesia after completing extensive interior upgrades and refurbishment.

In addition, Jet Works recently was awarded a multi-million dollar contract to design and install a 24 passenger VIP interior on a privately owned MD-87. The aircraft arrived at their facility several weeks ago and is already undergoing installation of the interior. Bryson pointed out that the MD-87 will feature a luxurious and contemporary cabin with a state-of-the-art in flight cabin entertainment system.

Bryson is joined in hosting the EBACE booth (Booth 2127) by Marc Johnson, Director of VIP Completion Sales.

Jet Works will be joined in their new booth by Phil Jordan, Managing Director of Business Air International, a sister company that specializes in the acquisition and sale of international private jets.

Operating out of approximately 100,000 square feet of hangar space, in addition to large cabin interiors, Jet Works offers heavy maintenance service, avionics and paint capabilities for 97 models of Boeing, Gulfstream, Challenger, Lear, and Citation business jets.

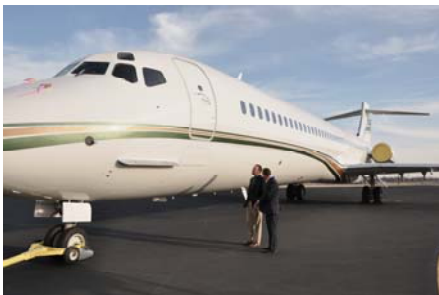
